Solo rider Donna Schwind from Johnson City nabbed Third Place with the time of one hour, six minutes, 42 seconds. Another solo rider, Korie Painter from Piney Flats placed Fourth with the time of one hour, 22 minutes, 30 seconds. Samantha Rabaud from Greenville placed Fifth with the time of one hour, 27 minutes, ten seconds. Rounding out the placements in the Field Hunter Division for Sixth Place was the team of Beth and Camille Fiszer from Roebuck with the time of one hour, 30 minutes, 20 seconds.

Columbus. Their time was one hour, 58 minutes, 28 seconds. Fifth Place was awarded to the team of Gale Ford from Winder and Daniela Leidy from Catawba with the time of two hours, 15 minutes, 20 seconds. Rounding out the placements in the Trail Rider division for Sixth Place was the team of Christian Glover from Bostic and Daniell Lamb from Marion with the time of two hours 14 minutes, 20 seconds.
